STRATEGIC GOALS & OBJECTIVES

2026-2030

This document provides a concise overview of North Florida College's strategic goals and objectives for the period of 2026-2030. These goals are designed to enhance the college's commitment to student success, community engagement, and operational excellence.



GOAL 1 – ENHANCE EXPERIENCES AND ENGAGEMENT

- Achieve ≥80% application-to-registration yield by 2030.
- Reach ≥90% employee participation in professional development by 2030.



GOAL 2 – EXPAND EDUCATIONAL ACCESS AND PATHWAYS

- Increase Career & Workforce Education (CWE) enrollment by 25% by 2030.
- Launch 4 new high-demand programs (≥2 in CWE fields) by 2030.
- Implement affordability initiatives, including expanded use of Open Educational Resources (OER).



GOAL 3 – STRENGTHEN COMMUNITY & INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIPS

- Host annual 'think tanks' in each service county.
- Increase industry partner advisory board participation by 30% by 2030.



GOAL 4 – ADVANCE OPERATIONAL EXCELLENCE AND MODERNIZE INFRASTRUCTURE

- Increase external funding by 20% by 2030.
- Transition 80% of paper-based processes to electronic workflows by 2030.
- Complete all deferred maintenance and refresh classroom technology on a 5-year cycle by 2030.
- Implement continuous improvement processes across 100% of major operations by 2030.
