The Practical Nursing (LPN) program is designed to prepare students to function as members of the health team in the prevention of illness and in the care and rehabilitation of the sick and injured. This is a limited access program.

CERTIFICATION: Successful completion of the LPN prepares graduates to take the National Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN). A passing score on this exam and registration with the Florida State Board of Nursing enables graduates to seek employment as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) in the state of Florida.
