The LPN to RN Accelerated Bridge Track is a one year/three semester program leading to an Associate in Science in Registered Nursing for individuals that already have certification and licensure as a practical nurse (LPN). This is a limited access program.



**CERTIFICATION:** Successful completion of the LPN to RN Accelerated Bridge Track prepares graduates to take the National Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN). Achievement of a passing score on this exam and licensure by the Florida State Board of Nursing enables the graduate to seek employment as a Registered Nurse in the state of Florida.
