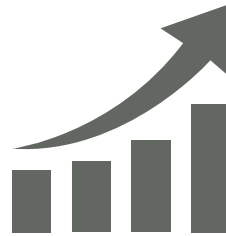

Academic Dual Enrollment

Take real college courses while still enrolled in high school at no cost to you!

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA, college-ready placement scores in reading, writing, and math, and school approval.

Career Dual Enrollment

Earn industry-recognized certifications that lead to careers in today's high-demand fields!

Applicants must be at least 16 years of age, maintain a minimum 2.0 high school GPA, and obtain approval from their school.

A combination of scores is accepted. Scores that are more than two years old may not be used for initial placement, 1008.30, Florida Statute. Rule 6A-10.0315 Demonstration of Readiness for College-Level Communication and Computation.

ACCUPLACER Next Generation and Mathematics:

- The QAS sub-test cut score for "college ready" per FLDOE is 261 | This qualifies students to take "gateway" courses MAT 1033, MGF 1130, MGF 1131, or STA 2023 at NFC.
- Students planning to take the algebra sequence of courses at NFC must take the AAF sub-test and score a minimum of 263 to be eligible for MAC 1105. Otherwise, students can use MAT 1033 as a prerequisite for MAC 1105 eligibility without a score from the AAF sub-test.

DUAL ENROLLMENT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

For Public, Private, and Charter High School Students



DISCUSS ELIGIBILITY WITH HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR

- Academic Dual Enrollment
 - 3.0 Unweighted High School GPA
 - College-ready Placement Scores in Reading, Writing, and Math
- Career Dual Enrollment
 - 2.0 Unweighted High School GPA
 - At least 16 years of age



SUBMIT THE DUAL ENROLLMENT ONLINE APPLICATION

Complete the NEW Dual Enrollment Student Online Application during the appropriate application window.

- Fall Term Start: April 1 – August 1
- Spring Term Start: September 1 – December 1



SUBMIT PARENT/GUARDIAN APPROVAL

Your parent or guardian must complete the online Dual Enrollment Approval Form.



MONITOR YOUR EMAIL FOR NFC ADMISSION INFORMATION

- After NFC Dual Enrollment & Early College Programs has reviewed your application, you will receive your NFC Dual Enrollment Admissions email, which includes your Student ID (G#) and NFC Student Email. Use this information to log in to the MyNFC portal and activate your account as a First-Time User.
- Important: After admission, all communication will be sent to your official NFC student email.



COMPLETE ONLINE DUAL ENROLLMENT ORIENTATION

- Complete the Online New Student Dual Enrollment Orientation Tutorial. This step is required before you can register for classes. Follow the instructions provided in the Orientation to submit your Dual Enrollment Course Registration Requests.
