## BASIC SKILLS REMINDER FOR CAREER DUAL ENROLLMENT

Students enrolled in Career Certificate programs of 450 hours or more must complete an attempt on an entry-level basic skills assessment within the first six (6) weeks of admission. Students must demonstrate the required basic skills for their program before a certificate of completion can be awarded. Reference: Section: 1004.91, FS, and Florida SBE Rule 6A-10.040.

If a student does not meet the minimum required basic skills level, as determined by an approved assessment, the student will receive targeted instruction to address the identified deficiencies. After remediation, the student must be retested using a different form of the same assessment, if available.
